We are excited about this year's West Central District 4-H Horse Show that will be held May 30, 2009 at Latta Plantation in Huntersville, located in Mecklenburg County. Enclosed you will find all the items you need to register for the Southwest District Qualifying Show.

There have been some rule changes and you may find that the class sheet and registration form has a few changes from previous years. The classes are arranged so that it is possible to show in more than one discipline and qualify as long as you place accordingly. It is the responsibility of all 4-H'ers to be aware of any rule changes that may affect them. Please read over the entire packet thoroughly.

Each 4-H member must hold an eligibility card, which has been signed by your County Extension Agent. Along with the eligibility card for each horse you are showing, you must show the **original copy** of your horse's negative Coggins test and lease papers upon registration at the district show. The name of the horse on the Coggins and the name of the horse that is being entered district must match. All horses must have a negative Coggins and be kept in a stall if on the grounds overnight. After an Extension Agent reviews the Coggins and eligibility of each 4-H member then the 4-H'er will receive a show number. All 4-H'ers who will be leasing a horse must have proper documentation. All horses purchased or leased must be in the child's possession at least 30 days prior to the district show. A lease agreement is required for all leased horses.

Coggins, Lease and Eligibility cards will be checked upon arrival. Please have these forms handy as you arrive at Latta Plantation. All ponies not holding a permanent USEF card must be measured before registering with the show office.

Please remember, NO hardship requests (for State qualifications) are allowed this year. It is the responsibility of each 4-H'er and each leader to be aware of any rule changes. The updated Rule Book is now available on-line at:

Any youth staying on the grounds overnight must have an adult chaperone.

All classes except Cloverbud classes have a \$6 entry fee. Please mail the enclosed, completed registration form and all fees: class entry, stall and shaving fees.

A one-time fee of \$50.00 per horse/rider pair will be added for any late entries. **IMPORTANT: ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY APRIL 30, 2009!** Entries not **postmarked** the April 30th deadline should be registered on-site. Each horse and child **MUST** be registered in AT LEAST one class. You will have the opportunity to add classes on site. Please note that current policy as recommended by the Advisory Board is that no district show fees, including entry, stall, etc. will be refunded if the amount is less than \$25.00. Entries canceled after the deadline date will only receive a refund upon receipt of a physician or veterinarian's certificate.

The show grounds gate will open at 2:00pm on Friday, May 29, 2009 and remain open until 10:00pm for hauling in horses. It will reopen at 6:00am on Saturday, May 30, 2009. The show office will open on Friday from 3:00pm-8:00pm for early check in. It will reopen at 7:00am Saturday morning. Show packets may be picked up after receiving check-in card from Show Chair and Agent Advisors. In case of severe weather conditions, you will need to contact the Mecklenburg County Extension office at (704)336-2082.

Ponies will be measured from 3:00 pm – 6:00 pm on Friday, 7:00 am – 8:00 am on Saturday. They will be measured at the wash pits at the end of barn A.

Schooling will be allowed Friday evening until 10:00pm, Saturday morning until 8:00am (hunter) and 9:00am (western). The arena lights will be turned off at 10:00pm each night.

For those needing hotel accommodations, a list of hotels is available in the packet. (You are responsible for your own reservations.) Also, there are RV and regular campsites available at Latta Plantation. Space is limited and reservations will be taken on a first come, first served basis. For more details, please see camping and hotel information sheets included in this packet.

The volunteers in the West Central District would like to thank everyone for their cooperation. Remember, we are all a part of the same program, working toward the goal of qualifying for the State 4-H Horse Show and much help is needed in order to have a good show. All parents, leaders, agents and 4-H'ers are urged to help the day of the show. Jumps have to be set, taken down and washed, the show grounds need to be cleaned, trail patterns need to be set, ribbons need to be handed out, etc. We also want to make sure that West Central District is well represented at the State 4-H Horse Show in Raleigh.

West Central District 4-H Horse Show Rules



1. A participant's County Extension Agent and his/her 4-H club leaders will determine certification of the eligibility of the 4-H member. Each eligible 4-H member will be given a 4-H Horse Project Card signed by his/her club leader and the Extension Agent. Rules for membership into the 4-H Horse Project will be determined by the county, however, it is encouraged that the 4-H members participate in additional 4-H events other than the 4-H Horse Show along with completion or partial completion of the record book.
2. Proof of negative Coggins test within the last twelve months is required. A completed 4-H Horse Eligibility Card must be presented with a negative Coggins test to enter. All Coggins tests must be originals, no Xeroxed copies will be accepted under any circumstances. **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!**
3. If the Coggins test is in the name of someone other than the 4-H'er, parent, or immediate family member, proof of ownership or lease must be presented.
4. If the Project horse is leased, the lease agreement must be signed at a minimum of 30 days prior to the West Central District (WCD) Horse Show.
5. Project horses should not be trained on a regular, daily basis by professionals within 30 days prior to competing in the WCD Horse Show. Professional advice and instruction for the 4-H member is encouraged whenever possible. Such assistance can include occasional, but cannot include regular training and care of the horse within 30 days of the WCD Horse Show. Youth boarding their horses at a public stable which feeds the horses and cleans the stalls are eligible to participate in the horse show if the 4-H'er rides and cares for the horse on a regular basis. 4-H Project horses must be ridden only by 4-H members on the day of the show and abuse of this rule will result in immediate rejection from the show. No parents or any other adult may ride the horse while on show grounds.
6. Divisions:
 - Cloverbud Division: Open to those youth who have reached their 5th birthday but who have not reached their 9th birthday as of January 1 of the current year; Non-competitive; Non-qualifying.
 - Junior Division: Open to those youth who have reached their 9th birthday but who have not reached their 14th birthday as of January 1 of the current year.
 - Senior Division: Open to those youth who have reached their 14th birthday but who have not reached their 19th birthday as of January 1 of the current year.
 - Short Stirrup Division (Hunter): 9 to 12 year olds in their first two years of showing over fences. These youth are ineligible to compete at the Regional Competition.
 - Little Britches (Western): 9 to 12 year olds in their first two years of showing. These youth are ineligible to compete at the Regional Competition.

- Non-Trotting Division: Walking and racking pads are allowed. Action devices are not allowed.
- Saddle seat Division: Open to trotting breeds only. Pads and weighted shoes are allowed. Action devices are not.
- Adaptive Division: Non-qualifying classes. No cross entry.
- Dressage: Invitational; Non-qualifying.

7. Pony Classification: Ponies in all divisions are 14.2 hands and under.
8. Each exhibitor in the State 4-H Horse Show must qualify at the District Horse Show in each division in which they wish to participate. For example: Exhibitors qualifying in western pleasure in the district show will only be allowed to enter western division classes. Exhibitors will be allowed to enter any class in the division for which they qualified in the district show. The horses and exhibitors must meet the class requirements for the division in which they enter.
9. The first three places of the qualifying classes at the district show, along with any participant who has achieved at least one point based on the following point system (with the exception of the State Invitational Classes) is qualified.

10. The use of ASTM SEI approved protective headgear is required in all hunt seat and short stirrup division classes and when mounted on the show grounds. Note: All games youth are required to wear a helmet. Participants are encouraged to wear protective helmets in all styles of riding. A current list of approved headgear can be obtained from the ASTM SEI.
11. The show committee and Agent Advisors will rule on complaints regarding violations on show rules.
12. Protest Rules: In order for the show committee to act, a verbal protest must be submitted immediately upon conclusion of the class. A written and signed protest must be filed by the complaining party accompanied with a \$25.00 deposit within fifteen minutes of the conclusion of the class. If the appeals committee upholds the

protest, the deposit shall be refunded. If the protest is overruled, the deposit shall be forfeited to the WCD 4-H Horse Program. These appeals and complaints must be directed by an exhibitor and/or spokesperson for the exhibitor and should be registered with the show committee. The show committee will serve as the appeals committee and act upon any protest. Eligibility of participants and horses cannot be protested.

13. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGE IS FINAL. ALL HORSES AND PONIES CANNOT WIN, THEREFORE, THE JUDGE'S DECISION, WHATEVER IT MAY BE, SHOULD BE ACCEPTED IN THE TRUE SPIRIT OF SPORTSMANSHIP AND 4-H.

When an exhibitor or exhibitor's parent, leader or agent is guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct, the show management may suspend such exhibitor's right to participate in future classes and/or shows for a period as deemed appropriate. The exhibitor's parent, leader or agent can and will be barred from show grounds for unsportsmanlike conduct or improper behavior.

14. An exhibitor may show only one animal in each class. With the exception of Trail, Reining, Western Riding, and Games in which an exhibitor may show 1-horse and 1-pony.
15. There will be no Hardships granted this year for any reason.
16. Rules for the District Horse Show not covered here are governed by the State 4-H Horse Rules and Regulations Manual.
17. The state now requires that all districts must offer at least a minimum of classes per each division offered at the state show. In the event of inclement weather and the show is operated on the raindate (May 31, 2009) the minimum district show Standard Qualifying Class List will be posted at the show office.
18. All participants must pay for classes when registering. There will be NO tabs ran for anyone.
19. If you scratch a class, you lose that entry fee money. **No substitutions.**

****Please be advised that beginning January 1, 2010 all riders will be required to wear protective headgear that meets or surpasses ASTM/SEI standards****

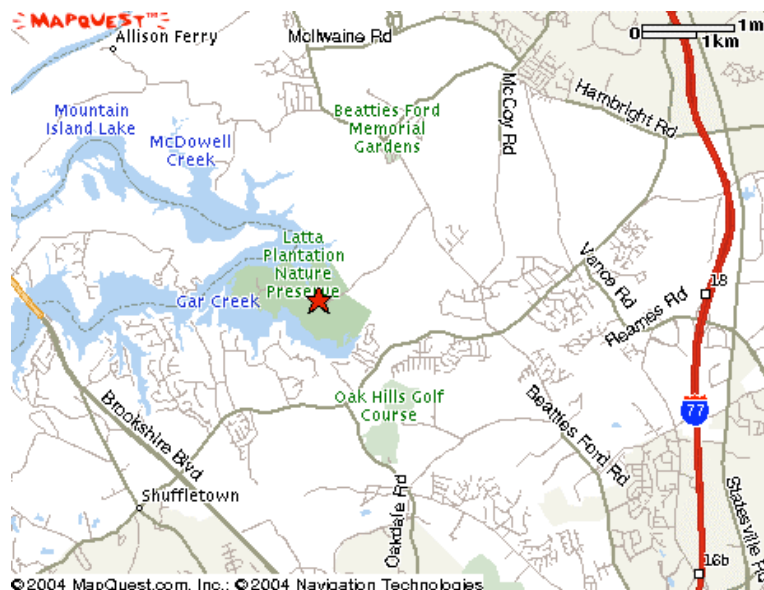
Historic Latta Plantation is 12 miles Northwest of Charlotte, NC
